Walton on the Hill Primary School want as many people as possible to be able to use this website and is committed to making this website accessible to visitors with disabilities.

Website Accessibility Features

- **Responsive Design:** Our website is designed to work on various devices and screen sizes, including desktop computers, tablets, and smartphones.
- **Keyboard Navigation:** The website is navigable via keyboard to accommodate users who cannot use a mouse.
- **Text Readability:** We use clear and legible fonts, sufficient colour contrast, and adjustable text size to enhance readability.

Users should be able to:

- change colours, contrast levels and fonts using browser or device settings
- zoom in up to 400% without the text spilling off the screen
- navigate most of the website using a keyboard or speech recognition software
- listen to most of the website using a screen reader (including the most recent versions of JAWS, NVDA and VoiceOver)

We've also made the website text as simple as possible to understand.

Walton on the Hill Primary School strives to conform to Web Content Accessibility Guidelines 2.2, Level AA. These recommendations outline how to make website content accessible to a wider range of people with disabilities however schools are partially exempt from the accessibility regulations.
